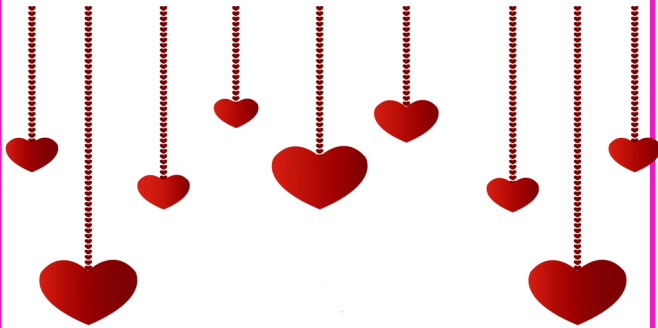


# Valentine's Day Tea

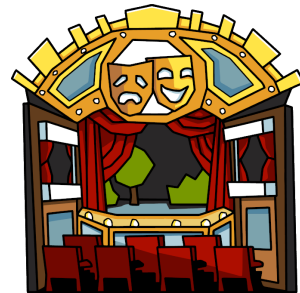

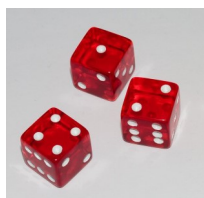
